arts

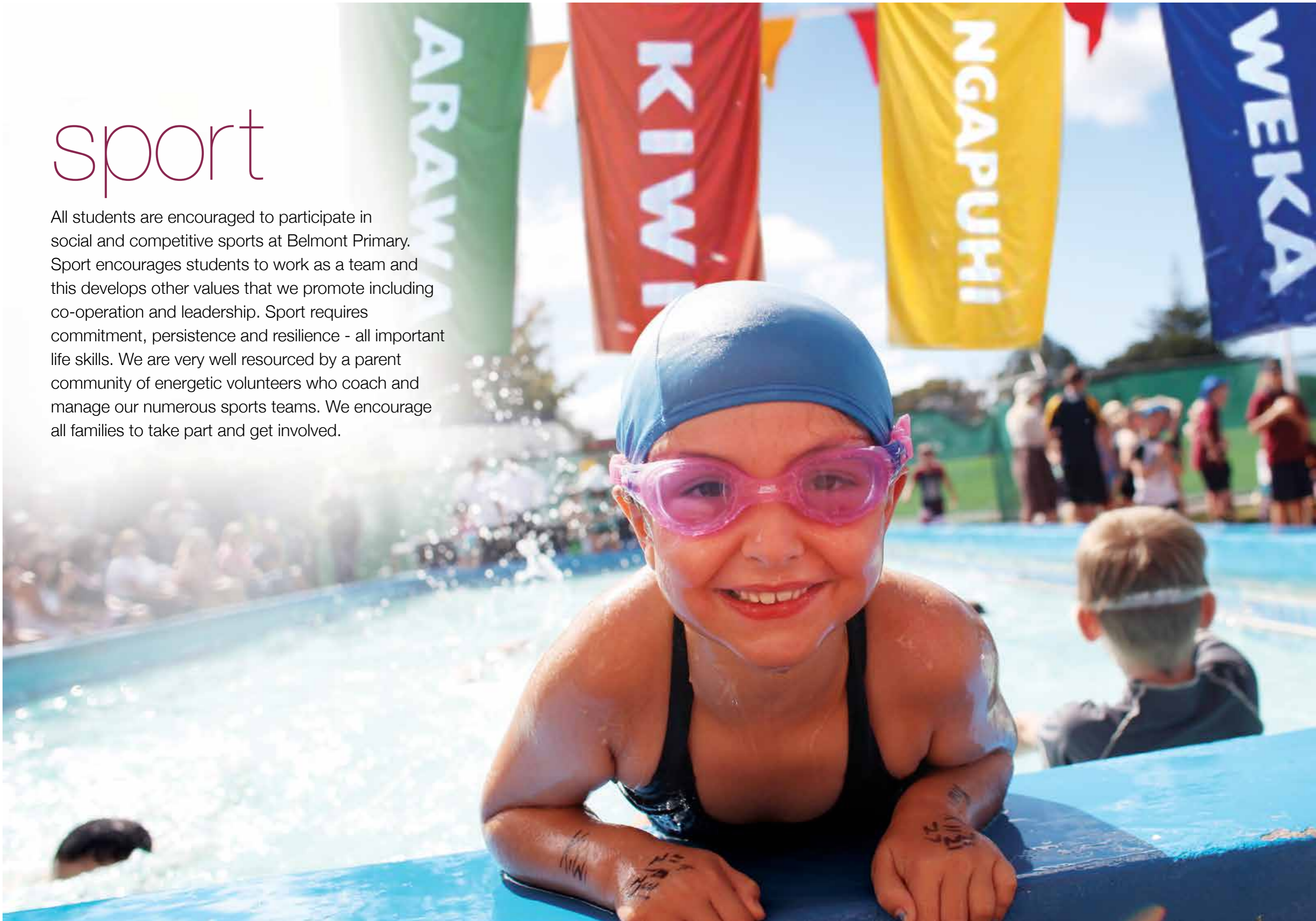
